

Ossawa, 22nd January, 1910.

Sir,-

With reference to your letter of the 14th instant, with which you forwarded an account rendered at \$7.50, in favor of Constable Edward R. Shaw, for services in a liquor case, I beg to say that in accordance with the usual custom, the account was transmitted to the Department of Justice for taxation previous to the question of payment being considered. A letter has now been received from that Department in which it is stated that the account appears to be in accordance with the tariff if the case took over four hours, but if not the fee for attending trial could be reduced from 1.00 to \$1.00. Under the circumstances, I have to request that you will kindly state the length of time occupied by the case in question.
