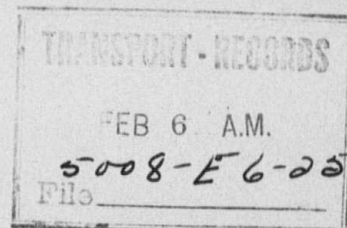

2. The subject aircraft has been reconditioned by Engineer N. Langlois under the supervision of B and D Engineer P. Davis, who has certified same as airworthy. The engine installed is brand new with a total time of two hours and fifteen minutes. One cylinder was removed to check for internal corrosion and found satisfactory. The machine has been weighed and the weight established at 1,232 pounds on wheels. Satisfactory test flight has been carried out by Pilot Albert Racicot.

3. This application appears in order, and issue of certificates is recommended.
