

Les mailles des filets ne devront pas avoir moins d'un pouce et un huitième.

N.-B.—La pêche à la ligne (canne et ligne) seule est autorisée dans les lacs et les rivières sous le contrôle du gouvernement de la province de Québec. Pour toute autre espèce de pêche il faut un permis.

Toute personne non domiciliée dans la province de Québec, est obligée de se procurer un permis pour pêcher dans les limites de la province, y compris les eaux où le droit de pêche est privé ou loué de la Couronne.

FISHING

CLOSE SEASON

1. SALMON, 31st July to 1st May. Angling; from 15th August to 1st May.
2. OUANANICHE, from 1st October to 30th November.
3. SPECKLED TROUT, *Salvelinus fontinalis*, from 1st October to 30th April. Fishing through the ice prohibited.
4. LARGE GRAY TROUT, lunge, touladi, landlocked, salmon, *Salmo confinis*. From 15th October to 1st December.
5. PICKERED, minimum size 15 inches, from 15th April to 15th May.
6. BASS, minimum size 9 inches, from 1st May to 15th June.
7. SMELTS, from 1st April to 30th June, (the use of seines is prohibited.)
8. WHITE FISH, from 10th November to 1st December.
9. MASKINONGE, minimum size, 24 inches, from 15th April to 15th June.
10. STURGEON, minimum size 36 inches, from 1st to 30th June.
11. EELS, minimum size 30 inches. The mesh for an eel weir shall not be less than one and one eight inch bar measure.

N.-B.—Angling only by hand, (with rod and line), is permitted for taking fish in the lakes and rivers under control of the Government of the Province of Quebec. For all other kind of fishing, a license is required.

No person who is not domiciled in the Province of Quebec can fish within the limits of the Province including waters in which the fishing rights are private or leased from the Crown, without having previously obtained a permit to that effect.
