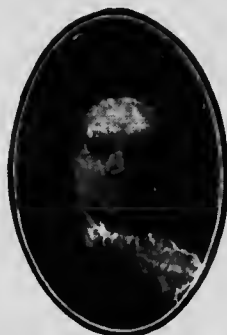


Pointe-aux-Trembles Mission Schools.
