## CAP. XXII.

An Act to provide for the punishment of Offences against the Person and Property, and to repeal the Act relating to Treasons and Felonies.

[18th *April*, 1836.]

HEREAS it is expedient to provide for the punishment of Offences against the Person and Property, and to repeal the Act relating to Treasons and Felonies: Be it therefore enacted, by What shall be the President, Council and Assembly, That if any Treason. person or persons shall compass or imagine the death of the King, or shall levy War against him, or adhere to his Enemies, or shall give them aid or comfort, or shall forge or counterfeit the King's Money, being Gold or Silver Coin of England, or of Great Britain or Ireland, or of this Island, or shall counterfeit the King's Great Seal or Privy Seal, or the Seal of this Island, and shall thereof be duly convicted, the person or persons so offending are hereby declared and adjudged to be Traitors, and shall suffer as in cases of High Treason; and that all Treasons declared by the Acts of Par- All Treasons by liament of England or of Great Britain, shall be Parliament to be deemed and adjudged to be Treasons within this deemed Treasons within this in this Colony.
