Canada's Castle Garden

Winnipeg, April 8. - New York's Castle Garden, where millions of European immigrants have first trod American soil, has long been touted the most cosmopolitan spot on the continent, if not in the world.

The visitor to this station at a time when one of the great colonist trains with its ten, twelve or even sixteen cars of humanity steams in from the east, suddenly finds himself unable to study, as he had hoped, the class of immigration which is flooding into the northwest.

Today the advices from the eastern immigration officers, who daily send invoices of the cargoes of mankind they ship west, contained a notification that three hundred Scotch, four hundred English, one hundred Galicians and a mixed lot of Austrians, Hungarians, Servians, Swedes, Italians and Alsations had been sent on one wave of the torrent sweeping into the territories.

These advices received, the immigration officials prepared to meet the daily struggle which arranging for the forwarding and final location of the intending settlers involves.

In the clamor for information, for food and for a resting place, the Englishmen have the best of it. The Scotch bring most of all three with them.
