INTERNATIONAL BIBLE LESSON FOR TO-MORROW.

Death of John the Baptist.—Mark 6, 14-29. Read Matt. 14, 1-12.

Golden Text.—Be not drunk with wine, wherein is riot, but be filled with the Spirit.—Eph. 5, 18. R. V.

No wonder, when John was in prison and completely in Herod's power, that he sent some of his disciples to ask Jesus if he were indeed the Messiah.

Matt. 11, 3.—To leave a loved cousin, fellow-laborer and forerunner in such a plight did not look very like it. Herod heard of Jesus' fame, and though a Sadducee, one who rejected the doctrine of a resurrection, yet he was haunted with the thought—Vs. 14-16—that John, whom he had beheaded, had risen again.

We have here the black history of Herod and Herodias—he had taken his own niece who had become the wife of his brother, and divorced his lawful wife for her sake.

John had said to him, "It is not lawful for thee to have thy brother's wife." This maddened Herodias, who plotted his death. Were men of God moved to rebuke the sins of royalty face to face to-day they would fare no better.

John's faithful personal dealing with this wretched king is a needed example for plain, personal dealing with sin and sinners, in love, but regardless of consequences, and Christians are respected, though unheeded, when they do so.

The convenient season for Herodias was Herod's birthday party in the palace, to make it a death day in the dungeon for John. Herodias' dancing daughter captured the king and his court, and he swore a boasting promise on oath to give her even to the half of his kingdom for the asking, and mother and daughter desired most the noble head of this prophet of God, who was faithful unto death, and received a young, human life, while his poor, blind, murderers were cut off in their sins; for Herod, to save the false honor of his oath before his courtiers, ordered John's beheading. This sad and savage deed, which grand a young, human life, at so critical a time, is often repeated to-day in the history of Christian missions; but the blood of the martyrs is the seed of the church, and precious seed it is.

We of the 20th century may look back on century 1 and think those were dark and brutal times, but life is held as cheap to-day—if only half of what our daily press reports be true—as even it has been in the past. The unwritten history of Russia can duplicate our lesson in several of her provinces and governors.

A PRETTY JACKET.

Among the new designs there are some very charming house jackets for girls, and one of the most practical for the home dressmaker is shown here. It is the essence of simplicity, having no contrasting elaboration of any kind save the ribbon girdling the waist. It consists of a pointed yoke which depends the full gathered sack. The deep collar is extremely graceful, being created by tucking the straight piece of the material to a depth of two or three inches, and allowing the fullness therefrom to provide the ripple for the edges. Two narrow tucks on the edge assist the flare and the same is used to construct the full at the waist. A pretty challis or silk would be excellent for this design, while the waisting fabrics are also suitable. The jacket is so easily made that the girl may also do it herself. For the medium size three yards of 36-inch material are needed.
