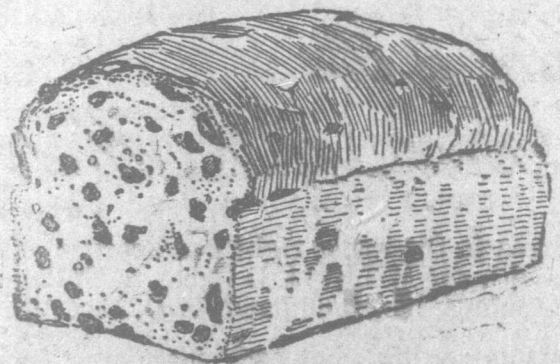

Ways and Means

REMOVE REASONS FOR ITS DEPARTURE AND IT WILL COME BACK, SAY EXPERTS.
PARIS, April 9.—That German capital abroad cannot be brought back to Germany by the passage of restrictive or regulatory legislation, in other words it cannot be forced back, but will return of its own accord when fundamental causes for its departure are removed, are the conclusions reached by the Second Committee of Experts, (known as the McKenna Committee) which has held 38 meetings in Paris and Berlin to consider this matter and whose report is now issued.

McGill Will Drop the L.L.B. Course

MONTREAL, April 9.—Beginning with the next session at McGill University the L.L.B. course will be dropped in the faculty of law and its place the University proposes to develop advanced legal teaching for special students along certain specified lines. The dropping of the course has been deemed advisable owing to the fact that bar regulations in their provinces make it very difficult for common law students to study outside of their own province.

Imperial Conferences

CANADIAN STATESMAN ON DOMINION ATTITUDE.

The Hon. Ernest Lapointe, Canadian Minister of Justice, speaking at Ottawa with reference to the Imperial Conference, declared that any attempt to make the Conferences executive rather than merely advisory would be a dangerous mistake. The Parliament of Canada would never subscribe to the doctrine that any decisions of a Conference were binding either on Great Britain or any Dominion without ratification by their respective Parliaments. Each part of the Empire must be free to adopt its own tariff policies according to individual needs.

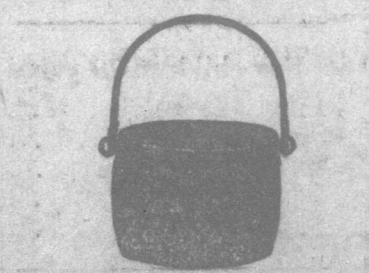

Ex-Caliph in Switzerland

ARRIVAL WITH FOUR WIVES.

VEVEY, Mar. 19.—The ex-Caliph who arrived at the Grand Hotel, Terzite, last night, was held up for half an hour at Brigue while the frontier officials communicated with the Ministry of the Interior at Bern, which eventually granted the necessary permission for him to enter Switzerland. Abdul Medjid was accompanied by his son and daughter and four wives, three of whom were veiled. They shrank timidly from the gaze of the few people who were assembled in the vestibule of the hotel, and appeared thankful to reach the suite of rooms which had been hurriedly prepared for their arrival.

The party was closely guarded by Swiss detectives, a precaution which Abdul Medjid later intimated was unnecessary for the future, inasmuch as, not being occupied with politics, he had nothing to fear.

Fatigued by the long journey, Medjid remained in his room all day. A member of his suite told me that to Medjid, who had never before left Constantinople, the journey was one unceasing wonderment. He has expressed delight in the fact that now he will be able to gratify his desire to study Western customs more thoroughly.

His plans for the future are unsettled. The private fortunes of the entire dynasty having been confiscated, everything depends upon the conditions the Turkish Government may decide to impose before granting him an adequate allowance. One thing, however, is certain, Medjid would never voluntarily relinquish the Caliphate, of which, he maintains he was illegally divested.

The Office of Tenebrae will again be sung to-night followed by a sermon. To-morrow morning there will be Mass of the Presanctified, followed by a procession. In the afternoon, Stations of the Cross will be held, whilst at night Tenebrae will again be sung followed by a sermon. On Saturday morning there will be Mass, at which the blessing of the Pascal fire, etc., will take place. All obligations for fast and abstinence cease at noon on Saturday. Rev. Father Pippy and one of the Priests of the Harbour Grace Diocese, left for St. George's on Sunday's express to bring in the Holy Oils which will be consecrated to-day. The Archbishop being in New York and the Bishop of Harbour Grace in Rome, his Lordship Bishop Renouf will consecrate the Holy Oils for the three Dioceses. The Church regulations require that these Holy Oils, while in transit, be in charge of a Priest.
