

Items from Ottawa. The Jones Committee on agricultural interests met on Wednesday morning and selected Mr. Jones as Chairman. A sub-committee was appointed to draft a report.

The Railway Committee considered the bill of the Montreal Telegraph Co. to enable them to extend their lines through Nova Scotia and increase their capital. A Nova Scotia Company now has exclusive rights, but it is proposed to override them in the public interest.

The Treaty Bill will not be introduced till Friday. Sir John's attempt to introduce important amendments to the Treaty without any explanation, was unappreciated. His object was to let Sir Francis Hincks first make his defence of the Treaty arrangements—his Budget speech—and, if possible draw out the opposition on the Treaty, so that he might shape his own course accordingly; but the Opposition prudently kept their own counsel.

Six soldiers have deserted from the Halifax garrison within the last few days. None of them have been recaptured.

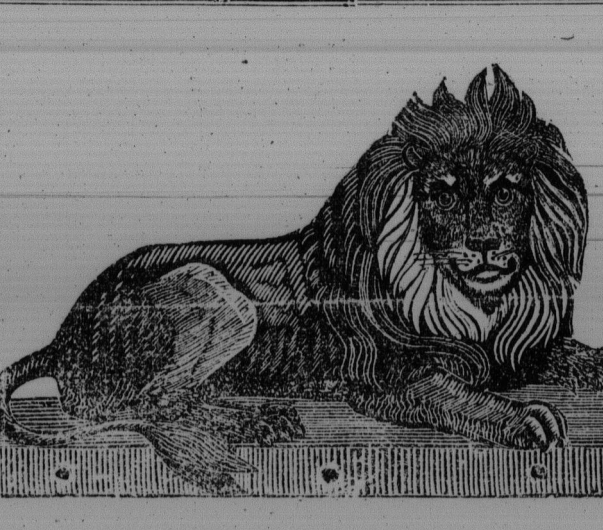
