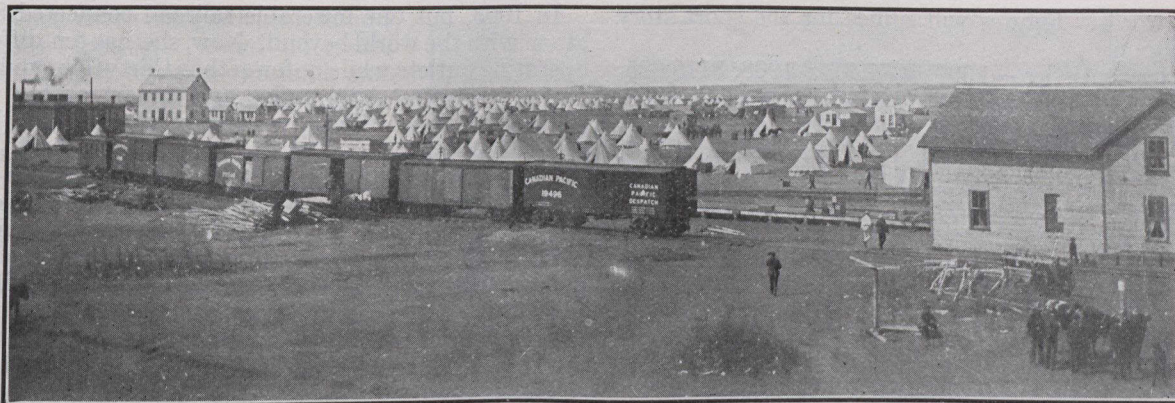
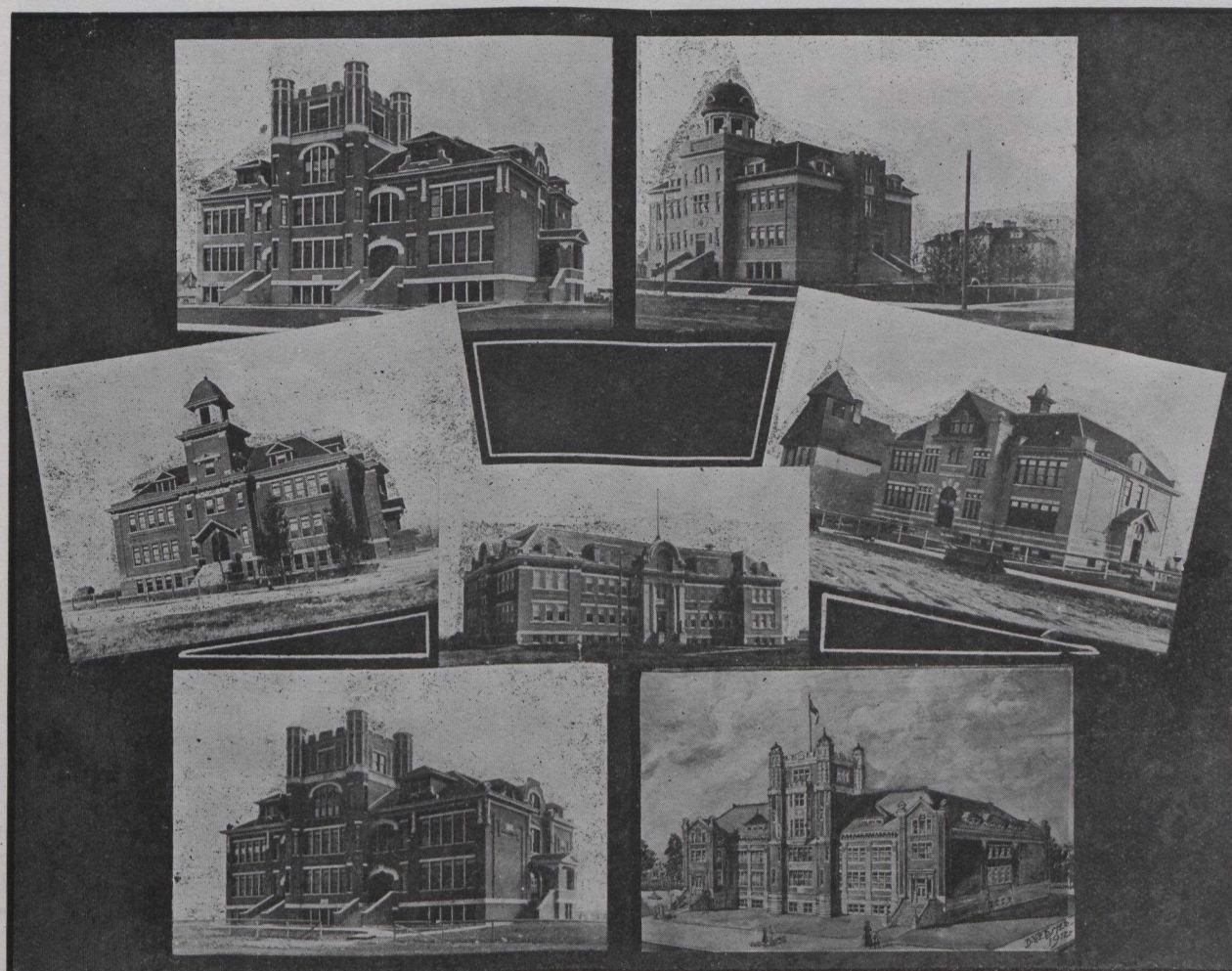




Saskatoon in the Spring of 1903, showing the village of tents of the Barr Colony.
