YOUR EXCELLENCY,

I have received your letter of today's date concerning the conditions which are to govern the training of Jamaican military personnel in Canada and confirm that the conditions set out in the Annex thereto entitled "Statement of Conditions to Govern the Training of Jamaican Military Personnel by the Canadian Forces in Canada" are acceptable. The Government of Jamaica therefore regard your letter and this reply as constituting an agreement between our two Governments which shall be deemed to have come into force on September 9, 1964, the date on which the first Jamaican Cadet entered Canada for military training, and which shall continue in force until terminated in the manner prescribed in paragraph 21 of the above mentioned Annex to your letter.
