## Canadian Actions Under the GATT

Since January 1, 1989, the following GATT panels have been established at Canada's request to examine and rule on U.S. trade practices.

- Federal and State Measures Concerning Alcoholic and Malt Beverages: Established in March, 1991, the findings of the panel will be made public at the end of April, 1992.
- Countervailing Duty Determination on Fresh, Chilled and Frozen Pork:
   Established in August, 1990, the panel found the United States had violated the GATT by assuming subsidies on the production of live swine were completely passed on to the exporters of processed pork. Duties paid by Canadian pork exporters were subsequently refunded.
- Initiation of Countervailing Duty Investigation on Magnesium: Established in January, 1992, the panel is to report in late summer, 1992.
- Initiation of Countervailing Duty Investigation on Softwood Lumber: Established in December, 1991, the panel is expected to report its finding in July, 1992.
