AS THE HONOURABLE HOWARD GREEN, SECRETARY OF STATE FOR EXTERNAL AFFAIRS, RECENTLY SAID IN THE HOUSE OF COMMONS, CANADA HAS DECIDED TO SUPPORT ACTIVELY THE PERMANENT COURT OF ARBITRATION AND OUR AMBASSADOR IN THE HAGUE IS REPRESENTING CANADA ON ITS ADMINISTRATIVE COUNCIL. FORTY-FOUR OTHER COUNTRIES ARE MEMBERS OF THE COURT WHICH WAS ESTABLISHED IN 1899 FOR THE SETTLEMENT OF DISPUTES BETWEEN STATES.
