DIPLOMATIC APPOINTMENTS

The Right Honourable Joe Clark, Secretary of State for External Affairs, announces the following diplomatic appointments:

Mr. William E. Bauer (59), born in Welland, Ontario, as Co-ordinator and Ambassador-at-large at the Conference on Security and Co-operation in Europe.

Mr. Bauer [B.A. (Honours), Queen's University, 1951; M.A., Public Administration, Queen's University, 1953] joined the Department of External Affairs in 1952. He has served abroad in Warsaw, Hanoi, Rome, Geneva, and Washington, D.C. In Ottawa, he has been Director, Staff Relations, from 1970 to 1974; Director, East Asia and Pacific Division, from 1974 to 1975; and Co-ordinator, Task Force/Visit of President Carter, and Co-ordinator, Energy Studies from 1979 to 1981. Mr. Bauer was appointed Ambassador to Thailand from 1975 to 1979; and Ambassador to Korea from 1981 to 1984. Since 1984, he has been a Foreign Service Visitor at Carleton University. Mr. Bauer replaces Mr. R.L. Rogers who has retired from the Public Service.
