VISIT OF THE SECRETARY OF STATE FOR EXTERNAL AFFAIRS

TO BRUSSELS, APRIL 16, 1987

The Secretary of State for External Affairs, the Right Honourable Joe Clark, will be travelling to Brussels, Belgium, on April 16, 1987, to attend a briefing by US Secretary of State, George Shultz, on the results of his recent trip to the USSR. Mr. Shultz will be briefing the North Atlantic Treaty Organization (NATO) Foreign Ministers on his discussions with General Secretary Mikhail Gorbachev and Foreign Minister Eduard Shevardnadze on East-West relations, including disarmament initiatives, and regional issues, human rights, and bilateral relations.
