PRAYERS.

Sixty petitions for Private Bills were presented in accordance with Standing Order 70(1).

Mr. Crestohl, seconded by Mr. McMillan, by leave of the House, introduced Bill C-74, An Act to amend the Immigration Act (Canadian's Parents), which was read the first time and ordered for a second reading at the next sitting of the House.

Mr. Crestohl, seconded by Mr. McMillan, by leave of the House, introduced Bill C-75, An Act to amend the Canadian Citizenship Act (Age Qualification), which was read the first time and ordered for a second reading at the next sitting of the House.

Mr. Ormiston, seconded by Mr. Hanbidge, by leave of the House, introduced Bill C-76, An Act to Found and Constitute the Western Canada Veterinary College, which was read the first time and ordered for a second reading at the next sitting of the House.

The following Questions were made Orders for Returns under the provisions of Standing Order 39(4):

Question No. 593, by Mr. Badanai,—Order of the House for a Return showing: Of the total of 127,086 immigrants receiving government aid between 1951 and March 31, 1962, what was the breakdown by year, the form of assistance, and the country of origin of each?
