Bill C-23 is designed to ensure that those people pay their fair share in taxes. That is the nature of the tax reform we will be introducing in the next Budget. It is tax reform designed to make sure that we can reduce the rate of taxation and lower the individual's requirement to pay. This Bill is fair as it attempts to make sure that those who pay sales tax receive a sales tax rebate.

I suggest that this Bill should be passed immediately, and, on that basis, I move:
