

## NOTICES OF MOTIONS.

Mr. *Clarke*—On Monday next—INQUIRY OF MINISTRY—What was the average speed per hour made during the year 1901 by steamships carrying British and Canadian mails from ports in the United Kingdom to Canadian ports; and from Canadian ports to ports in the United Kingdom respectively?

Mr. *Bennett*—On Monday next—INQUIRY OF MINISTRY—Is the Government aware that at a meeting held on the 5th day of February, instant, in the City of Toronto, the following resolution was passed unanimously by the Shorthorn Breeders' Association: "We, the members of the Dominion Shorthorn Breeders' Association, at our annual meeting, resolve that the tubercular test is unreliable, unnecessary, and in many cases injurious, and that we urge the discontinuance of the compulsory use of toxine by the Dominion Government Department of Agriculture; and we also fail to see the object now of requiring a 90 days' quarantine, as there is no contagious disease in Great Britain requiring its enforcement to such length of time."

In view of the above action, is it the intention of the Government to meet the wishes of the said Association?

Mr. *Bennett*—On Monday next—INQUIRY OF MINISTRY—Is the Prime Minister correctly reported in the *Hansard* of April 24th, 1899, as having stated that "the question of introducing legislation to provide for the compulsory retirement of County Court Judges in the Province of Ontario who had attained the age of seventy-five years was under the consideration of the Government"?

If correctly reported, is legislation to such end to be introduced this session?

If such legislation is introduced, will similar legislation be introduced in reference to the Judges of the Supreme Court of Canada and Judges of the High Court of Justice in the Province of Ontario?

Mr. *Robinson* (Elgin)—On Monday next—INQUIRY OF MINISTRY—Is it the intention of the Government to comply with the resolution passed during the last session relative to the appointment of a commission to inquire into and adjust all differences that may arise between the public and the railway companies of Canada?

Mr. *Hughes* (Victoria)—On Monday next—INQUIRY OF MINISTRY—Has the Government considered the Act passed at the last session of the Ontario Legislature extending its duration?

Has it allowed the Act, or is it the intention of the Government to disallow it?

If it is not to be disallowed, what are the reasons for non-disallowance?

Mr. *Hughes* (Victoria)—On Monday next—INQUIRY OF MINISTRY—How many courts-martial have taken place in the Canadian Militia since June 1st, 1901, up to January 1st, 1902?

What were the offences?

What were the punishments?

What is the total Permanent Force in Canada, classified by departments?

What is the number of minor punishments recorded in the Permanent Corps for the period above named?
