ARTICLE XVIII.

The Secretary shall keep a correct account of all proceedings at each and every meeting of the Company, also of monies received, absentees, delinquents, &c.

ARTICLE XIX.

That any Member leaving the Company, or being expelled therefrom, may leave his tunic and shell jacket in the Company, for which he shall be remunerated according to valuation by the Company.

ARTICLE XX.

All motions for alterations in the foregoing By-Laws, &c. shall be laid before the Meeting in writing accompanied by name of proposer and seconder, and all such motions for alterations or amendments shall be laid over until the next monthly meeting.

ARTICLE XXI.

A member wishing to withdraw from the Company can do so on giving one month's notice, and settling his accounts in the Secretary's Books. The Captain shall then give him a formal discharge.
