

WHAT IS THE O.B.U.?

The Canadian O. B. U. is One Big Union of wage-earners.

The members have a common membership card.

No Initiation Fee on transferring from one unit of the organization to another.

Each local has absolute control of its own local business.

The funds and property of local units are the property of the members and cannot be confiscated by any officials. (See Clause 33.)

Low Initiation Fee and Per Capita Tax. (See Clauses 3 and 23.)

The Constitution of the O. B. U. places the control of the organization at all times in the hands of the membership. (Note Recall provisions in Clauses 11 to 14.)

Enclosed you will find the Constitution of the One Big Union. Compare this document with the Constitution of your International Union.
