

RULINGS

By Grand Master Fowler at the 51st annual session of the
R. W. Grand Lodge of New Brunswick,
held at Fairville, N. B.

1st. That any member who has been elected to office in Grand Lodge, but has not been installed in said office, is not a qualified Grand Lodge officer.

2nd. That No. 114 Lodge was only granted a temporary isolation, and is now under the jurisdiction of Sunbury County Lodge.

3rd. That Primary Lodges are bound to report to County Lodges.

4th. That no representatives of a Primary Lodge can sit and vote in Grand Lodge unless the Lodge to which the brother belongs has been previously reported to its County Lodge.

5th. That if a D. G. Chaplain withdraws from one Primary Lodge and does not join another, he loses his office of D. G. Chaplain.

So with any other officer of Grand Lodge.
