INSTRUCTIONS.

I. This book is for the use and guidance of the officers and employees of the Canadian Pacific Railway Company's Telegraph. It contains a complete list of the Telegraph Offices of the Canadian Pacific Railway Company and its connections, up to December 1st, 1912, together with the names of many places for which telegrams may be accepted for delivery by mail or telephone, or otherwise, from the nearest telegraph office. Additions, changes and corrections will be issued in "Tariff Circulars" every alternate month beginning with February.

II.—THIS LINE STATIONS.

Stations of the Canadian Pacific Railway Co.'s Telegraph are known as "This Line" Stations, and are indicated by the letters C. P. placed before the name.

"This Line" stations will "CHECK DIRECT" with each other, unless otherwise instructed, as for example, C. P. Parkdale, check Toronto.

Some offices ignore instructions to "CHECK DIRECT" on business with certain places listed in the Tariff Book as "tariff same as Philadelphia, check direct," and incorrectly credit and check such business with Philadelphia. This also applies to the checking of places whose rates are the same as to Baltimore and other places, and which should be "checked direct." Offices are instructed to check such places correctly.

III.—CONNECTING LINE STATIONS.

With the stations of companies named in this group, business will be checked direct.
