COMMITTEE FOR INVESTMENTS AND BLOCK SUM OF S. P. G.

This Committee has invested during 1865, \$4500 in Provincial Debentures for the benefit of the Superannuation Fund, the Reserved Fund, and the Endowment of Parishes.

They report that the Block Sum of the S. P. G. now falls \$1389 short of the amount required to pay the Missionaries who were on the S. P. G. list; and they have called upon the D. C. S. to fulfil the pledge given when the Block Sum was accepted from the S. P. G., and to provide means to make up the deficiency,

ENDOWMENT COMMITTEE.

The sum of \$868.27 has been returned to the Parish of Arichat, being the amount, with interest, of money held in trust for the sole purpose of building a Parsonage there.

The Committee ascertained that a good title to the property was held by the parish, and that the contracts had been entered into for the building.
