

## RULES FOR MARKING.

40-Pr., R. B. L. AND 9-Pr., R. M. L. Guns.

Diagram showing position of target (T) and bannerols. Distances being in feet.



POINTS-COMMON SHELL.

Elevation. Between bannerols 1 and 1-4 " " 2 " 1-3 " Direction. " " 3 " 2-1 " within limits -1 "

SHRAPNEL SHELL,

Elevation, under and over, fuze blind. Same points as for Common shell.

No points given for shells bursting beyond target, whether before or after graze.

Fuze, if acting within limits, and not more than 30 feet above plane, 4 extra. Shells grazing outside limits, over or under, to have no points for elevation or fuze.

If the 40-pounder gur is fired over a sea range, the system of marking will be the same as for 64-pr. R. M. L. Gun.

## SIGNALLING.

Range Officer to face the Battery. Every 15 feet over—one wave to right. Every 15 feet under—one wave to left. Elevation good—flag to be held vertically. Direct hit—flag to be waved right and left over head. Ricochet hit—flag to be waved horizontally.
