Directions and Instructions for Telegraphing Fire alarms:-Keys are left with the occupants of buildings in the vicinity of each fire alarm box. The following should be observed when a fire is discovered:—Go to the box, open the door and pull the hook all the way down (once only) and let it go. No fare shall be charged for children un-der eight years in charge of an aduit. Chil-dren over eight years and under twelve years charged half price; over that age, full

One trunk and articles that may be placed inside the cab are to be carried free. For every other article placed on the outside of the cab the cabman is entitled to 5 cents.
