MONTREAL, Nov. 14.-A . firm tone prevailed on the local stock market, in the early trading this morning, and a number of advances were made. National Breweries was the most active issue, gaining 1/4 to 521/4. Industrial Alcohol followed Breweries and rose a similar fraction to 17, the highest point touched in some months. Another strong feature was Consolidated Smelters, up 3/4 to 1563/4. Laurentide gained 1/4 to 80, as did also Asbestos to 961/2, while Brazilian was up 1/8 to 771/8. The weak spots were Belgo, down ½ at 99½, and Atlantic Sugar, off ¼ at 38.
