U. S. GIVES LEAGUE ARMAMENT DATA

Co-operates Towards Study For Projected Parley on Army Cuts

GENEVA, Nov. 13.—Co-operating with the League of Nations, the United States Government has helped towards the preparatory study for the projected international conference on the reduction of armaments by forwarding to Geneva complete information on the military, naval and air forces of the United States.

COUNCIL TO PREPARE Preparatory arrangements for the disarmament conference will be probably started by what is known as Council No. 2, which is to assemble at Geneva in the early days of December and which will concentrate its activities on the problems of disarmament.
