Sponge Cake. Beat three eggs very light and beat in gradually 1-2 cups granulated sugar and 1-2 cup cold water. Sift flour and measure two even cups and add two even teaspoons of baking powder. Mix with warm water. Cover and rise, then add one cup chopped nuts and five cups whole wheat flour. It will make a soft sticky dough. Bake till twice the original bulk and form into loaves.
