

PLAN WORLD CLINIC TO HEAL MALADIES OF BODY AND SOUL

Physicians and Clergymen Join Hands in Organizing Foundation to Combine Faith Methods With the Very Latest of Scientific Discoveries.

NEW YORK, March 22.—With the completion this week of the organization of the National Association for the Advancement of Scientific Healing, a body has come into existence without parallel in modern medical science. Its aim is to establish a foundation in this city with hospitals and centres throughout the country where the whole man will be treated—mind, body and soul.

While highly qualified physicians and neurologists will control the treatment of all patients, their work will be supplemented by the training and experience of the clergymen, the labor leader, the capitalist, the psychologist, the sociologist and the eugenicist.

More radical still for a medical organization, the co-operation of the clergy will be invited. If he has anything really helpful to offer he will be given a chance to demonstrate his abilities under the roof of the foundation, always subject, however, to the careful check of the qualified physician. It is proposed to correlate all branches of healing and to work through the men and women who have reached the highest pinnacle in their own specialty, whether it be Christian Science, Cousinism, psychoanalysis or osteopathy.

Dr. Edward S. Cowles, of 891 Park avenue, a well known physician and psychiatrist, conceived the idea and brought it to fruition since his appointment as a member of the special commission to investigate faith healing appointed by the Episcopal Church at its triennial convention, held recently in Portland, Ore. Edward G. Riggs is president of the association, Mrs. Minerva Finchot is first vice-president, Thomas A. Price is secretary, and Thomas L. Chadbourne is treasurer. The members of the executive board include W. G. McAdoo, George Gordon Battle, Samuel Untermyer, the Rev. W. H. Owen, the Rev. E. Clowes Chorley, historian of the Episcopal Church of the United States, and Austin Strong.

The association plans to meet from every angle the needs of what Dr. Cowles describes as a "half-sick world," with men and women who get up in the morning feeling tired and depressed, and yet not definitely ill. There is such a thing as indigestion of the mind as well as of the body, he says.

The primary objects of the association are:—
1. The promotion of a more scientific treatment of nervous disorders based upon a thorough and complete examination of the patient which shall include the physical, the mental, the spiritual, the social, the industrial and the environmental conditions, together with all other debilitating influences.
2. To encourage a broad and comprehensive study of the whole man.
3. To seek to prevent the development of insanity by early diagnosis and prompt treatment.
4. To correlate the work of the labor leader, the capitalist, the psychologist, the sociologist, the eugenicist and all other persons or groups interested in maintaining the health of the people.
5. To bring about a closer co-operation.

Kelly Raps Irish Republican Chiefs

Colonel Thinks Soviet Is Aiding Their Efforts.

New York, March 22.—Bitterly arraigning the leaders of the Republican movement in Ireland, as well as Irish-Americans here who gave them aid, Col. J. Sherwood Kelly, British army, retired, who arrived on the Carmanah of the Cunard line to visit friends, declared that De Valera's present methods were worse than the atrocities alleged to have been committed by the British 800 years ago. De Valera, whom he said was not even an Irishman, was being supported by funds raised by misguided Irish-Americans, according to Col. Kelly. He believed the Bolshevik Government of Russia also was supplying aid in the hope of breaking up the British Empire.

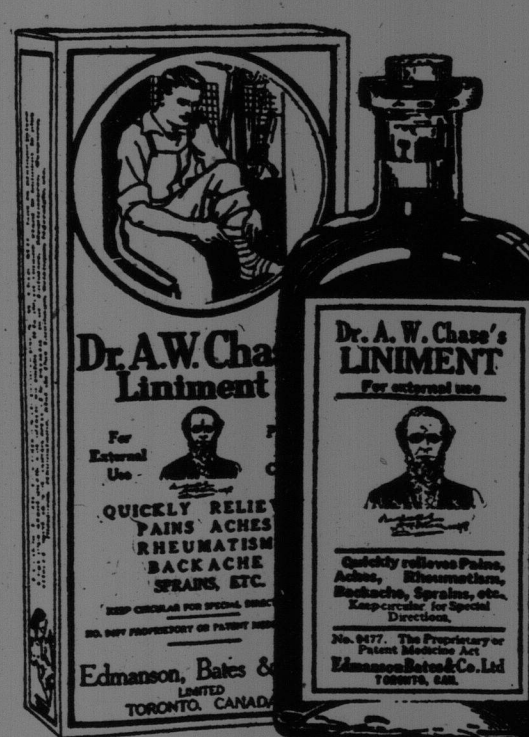
"The so-called Irish-Americans make me tired," he said. "Either they are Americans, in which case they are not Irish, or else they are Irish and English citizens and should not be fostering internal strife."

"Most of the Republicans don't even know what they are fighting for. They killed Michael Collins after he had obtained for them what had been the goal of loyal Irishmen for years."

Col. Kelly, it was said, possesses more decorations, with one exception, than any other officer in the British army. He served in the war with the Inniskillen Fusiliers, one of the oldest Irish regiments. At the close of the war he went to Russia for a time.
