





An amendment was introduced that was agreable to the C. N. R. It provided that the National Railway could not extend the line from Harvey to Vanceboro unless application for running rights over the C. P. R. from Harvey to Vanceboro had been denied. The bill was carried with the amendment. The bill providing for the line, four miles from Lockport Station to Lockport, in Nova Scotia, was carried.
