MEMO

The first outline survey of this reserve was made in 1878, and all the corners were re-marked with $\frac{1}{4}$ inch iron posts in 1885.

The Inner Two miles were subdivided into long narrow River Lots in 1894 and a number of patents have, issued, within the last few years, to claimants entitled to such.

On 24 Jan'y 1895 Mr. E. M. Coll. Insp. Indian Agencies, W. F. G., was instructed to inform the Indians that they would receive other lands in lieu of some to be patented. Beyond the Inner Two miles no subdivision of the reserve has ever been made.
