TOTAL OF 1,112 NEW CASES IN MONTREAL

Montreal, Oct. 21.—New cases of influenza reported in Montreal since Saturday afternoon amounted to 1,112. The deaths were 130. The number of new cases shows a slight increase over Friday and Saturday's returns.

REGULATIONS AS TO STRIKES, ETC.

Ottawa, Oct. 21.—To correct misunderstandings and misinterpretations of the recent order in council prohibiting strikes and lockouts for the period of the war, the following official statement is given out: "The government's action in passing the order referred to does not in any way restrain labor beyond the point its representatives voluntarily agreed to comply with the principles of strikes is not more stringent than its prohibition of lockouts. The penalties are the same in each case."
