

Courses of Instruction.

I. Classical Course.

This course extends over two years, and embraces the subjects required for admission to the full Arts Course in Acadia College.

II. Teacher's Course.

This course is designed for those who are intending to apply for Teacher's license of B, C or D grade.

III. Commercial Course.

This course embraces the subjects contained in the Classical Course, except Greek, for which French and German are substituted, and is designed to fit students for an English Course* at Acadia College.
