A merchant. First returned to Parlt. for present seat at last g.e. A Conservative.—*Bathurst.*

OTTY, GEORGE. [*Kings.*]

Called to the Bar, N.B., 1844. Sat for present seat for some years before the Union. Was an unsuccessful candidate for Kings in the Commons at g.e., 1867. Returned to present House at last g.e. A Conservative.—*Hampton Ferry.*

PALMER, RUFUS, *M.D., M.R.C.S.,* (Edin.) [*Albert.*]

Descended from an Am. loyalist. S. of Philip Palmer, Esq., of Sackville, N.B., who represented Westmoreland in N.B. Assembly for many years. B. at Sackville, 23 March, 1828. Ed. at the Mount Allison Academy, and at the Univ. of Glasgow, Scot., at which latter he carried off many prizes in the Medical School. M., Aug., 1862, Zelia, dau. of John McAlmon, Esq., of Hopewell. A M.R.C.S. (Edin.) First returned to Parlt. for present seat at last g.e. A Liberal.—*Riverside, Hopewell, N.B.*
