

An Act to divide the Quebec Turnpike Roads into two separate Trusts, and to make other provision relative thereto.

WHEREAS it is expedient to place the Turnpike Roads in the neighbourhood of the City of Quebec and the works therewith connected, under two separate sets of Trustees, the Roads and works on the North side of the River St. Lawrence to be under one set, and those on the South side of that River to be under the other set: Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of Canada, enacts as follows:

I. For and notwithstanding any thing in the Ordinance and Acts hereinafter mentioned or any of them, or in any other Act or Law, it shall be lawful for the Governor of this Province, by order in Council, to determine and declare, that upon, from and after a day to be therein named, the Turnpike Roads, Bridges, and other works in the neighbourhood of the City of Quebec made, purchased, or improved by or otherwise subject to the management, powers, or control of the Trustees of the Quebec Turnpike Roads, under the authority of the Ordinance of the Legislature of Lower Canada passed in the fourth year of Her Majesty's Reign, and intituled, *An Ordinance to provide for the improvement of certain Roads in the neighbourhood of and leading to the City of Quebec, and to raise a fund for that purpose*, or under the authority of the several Acts of the Parliament of this Province amending and extending the same, that is to say, the Act passed in the Session held in the fourth and fifth years of Her Majesty's Reign and chaptered seventy-two,—the Act passed in the eighth year of Her Majesty's Reign and chaptered fifty-five,—the Act passed in the ninth year of Her Majesty's Reign and chaptered sixty-eight,—the Act passed in the twelfth year of Her Majesty's Reign and chaptered one hundred and fifteen,—the Act passed in the Session held in the thirteenth and fourteenth years of Her Majesty's Reign and chaptered one hundred and two,—the Acts passed in the Session held in the fourteenth and fifteenth years of Her Majesty's Reign and chaptered, respectively, one hundred and thirty-two and one hundred and thirty-three,—the Act passed in the sixteenth year of Her Majesty's Reign and chaptered two hundred and thirty-five,—and the Act passed in the eighteenth year of Her Majesty's Reign and chaptered one hundred and sixty,—shall be divided into two separate Trusts, those of them which lie on the North side of the River St. Lawrence to be under the sole control, direction and management of Trustees to be called the *Quebec North Shore Turnpike Road Trustees*, and those of them which lie on the South side of the said River to be under the
