Devils in first place

The hockey Red Devils will be out to avenge losses against Saint Mary's Huskies and Acadia Ax-

emen Friday and Saturday at the Aitken Centre, but in a sense they also owe those two teams a debt of gratitude.

After going 7-0 during the exhibition schedule - including victories over Acadia and Saint Mary's -the Devils went to Nova Scotia on the opening weekend of regular season and endedup losing 7-5 to Acadia and 5-3 to the Huskies. The losses were by no means planned, but coach Don MacAdam admits they might have helped his

"Those losses aren't nearly as harmful as a lot of people made them out to be," he said. Since those losses, the Devils have racked up four straight victories, including road triumphs last weekned against Mount Allison Mounties (5-3) and St. Francis Xavier X-men (3-2).

"If we are going to have the type of season that we want, anything less than two victories this weekend won't be satisfactory," MacAdam said. "We've learned that we have to be mentally prepared for every

game we play. The real bonus so far this season has been that all 19 players dressed have been making a contribution...it hasn't

been a case of one line carrying us, or the defense carrying us, or anything like that. Everyone has been doing the job for us."

In Sackville, the Devils fired 43 shots at Mounties goaltender Todd Williams, and held Mount Allison to just 15 shots on Jamie Frizzell. "We held a tremendous advantage territorially in that game," MacAdam said. "The shots were indicative of the play."

· Al Lewis, Brian Thomson, Tom St. James, George Kelly and Bill MacDonald each counted one goal in that victory with St. James also picking up two assists.

In Antigonish, Dave Mancuso scored the tying goal and set up the winner in the 3-2 decision, with Lewis getting credit for the winning tally. Mark Welton scored the other goal, with Kevin Rochford picking up the win in goal.

UNB is now tied for first place with defending champion University of Moncton Blue Eagles with eight points each, although the

Eggles have played two less games and are still undefeated. The Devils have also scored the second most goals in the conference.

Saint Mary's, 1-4 so far this season, are here for Friday's 7:30 start while Acadia, 2-2, squares off against the Devils Saturday night, also at 7:30.


