

M^r Louis in obedience to an order which he received
 for that purpose from Lord Dorchester at that
 time General Cartetons and upon Reference to the
 Original Plan and process verbatim of this Survey
 by M^r Collins which accompanies this Report
 Your Excellency will perceive that the line
 of Separation between the two Seigneuries was
 run so as to leave within the limits of the
 Seignerie of LaBarrie or La Magdeleine the
 Mill Stream which is now claimed by the
 Indians and Your Excellency will also perceive
 from the Certificate of Col^l Claus then one of
 the Principal Officers of the Indian Department
 transcribed on the same plan that this line
 was run "in the presence of some of the"
 "Chiefs that they were satisfied therewith and"
 "unanimously approved of it"

I have to add that the Indians
 continued in possession of what was assigned
 to them by M^r Collins's Survey until the Year
 1799 when an Action was brought by the
 Indians in the Kings Bench of Montreal to
 set aside that line and to recover the Land
 which they now claim which was dismissed
