but there have been a number of dismissals. Some of these who were Roman Catholics have been replaced by Protestants, and I find evidence of a strong ill feeling on this account I purpose giving special attention to this Riding. At this date no candidate available or even talked about either for the Commons or Legislature.

JULY 12th

Organizer W.F. Summerhayes reports; " Saw E.J. Kyle director for Merrickville who is engineer at the Electric Light Plant, and a number of others. Kyle will look after the voters list revision, and is of opinion an early meeting should be held and that Prescott is the right place. He will communicate with J.D. Arnold of Wolford Township, and J. Cassida for Oxford Township.

AUGUST 6th

Organizer Summerhayes reports that Grenville reform Association meeting is to be called for the morning of Labor Day Monday September 2nd. I have seen Secretary Dr.C.F. McPherson of Prescott, J. Devine of Cardinal, Mr. McCrea a lawyer. The South Gower lists are posted.

AUGUST 29th

Time for appealing on South Gower lists expired yesterday. Wrote Township clerk as to any appeals.

Organizer Summerhayes saw in Prescott, Delbert Ferrin, Machinist, and J.A. Mundle assessor for Prescott. They have been in communication with S.J. Martin who told them to go ahead; and with Hon. George P. Graham as to attending annual meeting. Mr. Ferrin intends to get out notices for the meeting and go into every sub-division. S.J. Martin was absent from Kemptville and organizer Summerhayes wrote him he would be in Kemptville on Monday to revise the lists then (the last day) W.F. Summerhayes then spent three days in Augusta Township in company with Mr. Mundle who reports that he looked after Liberal lists thoroughly in making up the town lists.

The prospective candidate for the Commons is C.W. McLean of Brockville who is moving to Prescott and is a wealthy man.

SEPTEMBER 2nd

Organizer Summerhayes reports from Kemptville. I got three good men here and we went over the Kemptville lists. We have appeals for six to add and four to strike off.

SEPTEMBER 4th

Organizer Summerhayes reports " I covered four sub-divisions of Augusta Township yesterday, and last night we had a good meeting of workers in Prescott and Dr.C.F. McPherson the secretary included. They decided to hold the annual meeting of the Association for Friday 27th September. Hon. George P. Graham has consented to speak.

SEPTEMBER 5th

Organizer Summerhayes met in Brockville W.J. Bissell, Rufus Throop, John J. Burns, M.C. Franklin and others and completed examination of Augusta lists, and appeals handed in to add six names and strike off nine besides corrections
