

of the accounts and consideration of the reports submitted by Dr. Haney, fixed the rates of remuneration at the amount which has already been offered him as just and equitable for the services rendered, the Superintendent General cannot see clearly how he can re-open the case.

He will, however, adhere to his offer made on the 9th May last to allow Dr. Haney interest on the sum tendered him from the date at which the bill was incurred.
