



Sir,-

With reference to your letter of the 27th ultimo in which you state that the Chiefs of the Six Nation Council desires to have the sum of \$200.00 advanced from Band funds of the Six Nations Agricultural Society for the purpose of making an extension to their fair grounds, I beg to say that the Department desires a report from you as to the need for additional grounds. The Department is of opinion that the money which would be required to purchase the land could be expended to more advantage if prizes were bought to encourage the Indians to exhibit at the fair.
