right of way. On its receipt the usual Order in Council will be applied for but the patent will not issue until the matter has been finally dealt with by the British Columbia Government.

The consideration of your application for an area of 60.3 acres will probably require to remain in abeyance until the reserve itself has been finally confirmed after necessary action by the Royal Commission.
