
Ottawa, February 14, 1917.

Sir,-

I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 10th instant, making application for a small island off Wolf Island in the River St. Lawrence, and in reply to say that the plans of record in the Department do not show this island.

As it is possible that the island to which you now refer may originally have formed part of Wolf Island the Department would not be in a position to take any action in regard to disposition thereof unless it were clearly established that the island in question has always existed, as such, and has not been formed by the cutting away of a portion of the mainland of Wolf Island.
