# Form for Assembly and Proceedings of Field General Court Martial on Active Service.

## PROCEEDINGS.

On Active Service, this Eleventh day of June, 1945. Order convening the Court.

Whereas it appears to me, the undersigned, an officer in Command of 1 Canadian Infantry Brigade, on active service, that the persons named in the annexed Schedule, being subject to Military Law, have committed the offences in the said Schedule mentioned.
