1. Type - Piper Cub J3 L4B
Nationality - Canadian
Registration marks - CF-EGN
2. Name of Owner, operator and hirer if any, of the aircraft -
Canadian Aircraft Company, Regina.
3. Name of pilot-in-command - Adrian Valliere
4. Date and time of accident: June 14th, 1952, at approx-
imately 4 p.m. standard time.
5. Last point of departure and point of intended landing
of the aircraft - Regina, Saskatchewan.
6. Position of the aircraft with reference to some easily
defined geographical point - $4\frac{1}{2}$ miles N.W. of Rouleau,
Saskatchewan.
7. Number of persons killed and number seriously injured - none.
8. Nature of accident and the extent of damage to the aircraft
so far as is known - stall in turn and some bent tubing
and starboard wing.
9. Type of flying - non-scheduled.
10. Opinion as to the cause of the accident - stall in turn
and start of a spin too close to the ground for recovery.
"Pilot error".
