French word " Y "

Y is translated by the personal pronoun accompanied by a preposition.

Ex. : It is a fine post, he aimed at it.

C'est une belle charge, il y aspirait.

You are not fit for it.

Vous n'y êtes pas propre.

French word " Où "

Où is equivalent to a relative pronoun and a preposition.

Ex. : The state in which he is.

L'état où il est.

The affair on which my fame depends.

L'affaire d'où dépend ma réputation.

The end at which we aim.

Le but où nous tendons.

Où adverb of place is translated by *where*.

Ex. : Where do you go ?

Où allez-vous ?

Where do you come from ?

From where do you come

D'où venez-vous ?
