

shall be entered by the Secretary in a book kept for that purpose.

Any such Member shall be reinstated to all his privileges upon his return being notified in writing to the Secretary, and such notification be given within one month of his return, and upon payment of his subscription for the then current year ; failing in such notification and payment such Member shall be considered as having withdrawn himself from the Club, unless the Committee decide otherwise.

15.—Visitors.

Any Member, at his own expense, has the privilege of introducing one or more of his friends to the Visitors' rooms, and to breakfast, lunch, or dinner, and the name of each such friend shall be entered in the Visitors' Book.

Guests of any Member, with whom they have dined or lunched at the Club, shall, providing they are Conservatives, have access to any part of the Club, while such Member is with them ; but if not known to be Conservatives, then only access to the Visitors' room, and Private Dining room, while such Member is with them.

16.—Club Rules and Hours.

The Club House shall be open every day for the reception of Members at 8 a. m., and shall be closed and lights extinguished at 1 a. m., except on Saturdays and Sundays, when the hour of closing
