Left zygoma broken.  
Age, 20-25 .....  
Sex, female .....  
Sutures, serrations deep but simple .....  
Pterion, almost K shaped .....  
Inion, 0 .....  
Artificially lengthened occipital foramen, I .....  
Lateral parietes, protuberant, especially below  
    parietal eminences .....  
Glabella, small .....  
Superciliary ridges, absent .....  
Frontal eminences, indistinct .....  
Forehead, straight .....  
Vault, smoothly curved .....  
Probola, very prominent, globular .....  
Sub-iniac curve, on level with condyles .....  
Mastoid process, small .....  
Hollow at root of nose, none; root of nose wide  
    and flat .....  
Inferior border of nares, widely curved .....  
Wormian bones, one small in each occipito-mas-  
    toid suture .....
