

CAP. II.

An Act to continue an Act intituled "An Act, to regulate the cutting of Saw Logs, on the River Magagaudavis, and its various branches."

Passed the 7th March 1826.

BE it enacted by the Lieutenant-Governor, Council, and Assembly, That an Act passed in the third year of the Reign of His present Majesty King George the Fourth, intituled "An Act to regulate the cutting of Saw Logs on the River Magagaudavic and its various branches," be and the same is hereby continued and declared to be in full force until the first day of April one thousand eight hundred and thirty-one, and no longer.

Act 3, Geo. 4 c. 19, continued till 1st of April 1831.

CAP. III.

An Act to continue an Act intituled "An Act to empower and authorize the Justices of the County of Westmorland, at their General Sessions of the Peace, to regulate the grazing and depasturing the several Marshes Low Lands or Meadows, within the said County."

Passed the 7th of March 1826.

BE it enacted by the Lieutenant-Governor, Council and Assembly, That an Act made and passed in the fifty-fourth year of the Reign of His late Majesty King George the Third, intituled, "An Act to empower and authorize the Justices of the County of Westmoreland at their General Sessions of the Peace, to regulate the grazing and depasturing of the several Marshes, Low Lands or Meadows within the said County," be, and the same is hereby continued and declared to be in full force for five years and no longer.
