That the Account No. 14, gives credit erroneously for the sum levied under 45th Geo. The error above alluded to, is rectified in the Accounts of the succeeding year-The only further remark that your Committee see necessary to be made on these A_{c-} counts, is, that the incidental expenses attendant on the Collection of the Provincial Revenue of the Crown, appear to have increased considerably, and the cause thereof is not stated in the Accounts.
