When the Supreme Court, shall be impowered to try such Offenders, may hear, try and determine such Offenders at Halifax.

II. And be it further Enacted, by the Authority aforesaid, That when and as soon as the Supreme Court, Court of Assize and General Goal Delivery shall be impowered to proceed to the Trial of Offenders for any of the Crimes aforesaid, they are hereby impower'd to hear, try and determine, all such Offences at his Majesty's Supreme Court to be held at Halisax; in and for the said County, by a Jury of the said County, any Law, Usage or Custom, to the contrary Notwithstanding.

III. Brovided always, and be it further Enacted, That this Act and every Clause and Article therein contained shall be of Force for and during the present Rebellion in America and no longer.
